


Instructions:

- Print this page use a proper ruler to make sure the ruler has printed out at the correct scale. If it hasn't, you can still use the caliper use it to gauge the distance, then use another ruler to measure the distance between the 2 sides
- Cut out along the red lines.
- Fold along the green lines.
- Slip the ruler end into the guide (to make a caliper like below)
- Measure **BEFORE** expressing
- Slip the 2 ends along so that your nipple is between them (make sure you are 1-2mm away from the areola)
- This is your starting point eg, if you measure at 16mm start at 17mm. Most people appear to prefer a size that is very close to the diameter of their nipples.



- There are 3 considerations to flange sizing
 - Size
 - Comfort
 - Efficiency
- Note that your sizing may change and you may need to experiment with different sizes - maybe try my new flange lending service ;)
